We had two new circumstances on this hunt. WB6ODR bought four tiny transmitters from Byonics: <https://www.byonics.com/> . He used them for secondary transmitters and mounted them in pill bottles. They are easy to hide. It made the hunt more challenging. Not all hunters found all four. I, for instance, gave up on one as I got frustrated hunting around a very large boulder. It turns out, the transmitter was hidden in a crack on top of the boulder. With my bad balance, I never would have gone to the top looking for it.
